- Mention how you edited your 3D characters that you have used on packaging and e-portfolio

E-Portfolio

- Remember to link all files and add 3d characters
- It is a graphical unit and the e-portfolio should “sell” your products

Characters

- Use consistent fonts on your 2D characters. Title is different from instructions at present

Packaging

- Annotate prototype of packaging top, state vector & bitmap images
- Did you get any feedback? If so add it into your e-portfolio
- You need to take Photos of the final packaged product.
- Remember to update your design log and elements table

Backdrop

- Final backdrop image not in e-portfolio
- Make sure you also have mention feedback and a dimensions page for your backdrop.

Planning

- Detailed planning but needs to be updated.
- Mention how you used contingency time also

Elements table:

- Very detailed but very behind. Update with 3d characters, backdrop & packaging elements. Stating clearly your source for images and whether you created them or not.

Tell the tale:

- Not present.
- Make sure you get feedback
- Mark clearly where you would have bitmap and vector images
- Make sure it runs automatically and timings are suitable for audience
- It should end with over to you

Lauren Archer

- Be consistent with your link in your e-portfolio, they should either be white underlined or black underlined. (See planning/e-portfolio menu to see what I mean)
- Edit character on bottom left and remove white background
- E-portfolio size is very large (~60MB) Compress what you can
- The white text is difficult to read, consider changing font colour
- Need dimensions for packaging top
- Annotate packaging top and state which image is vector/bitmap
- Need to update your project plan and state clearly why you were not up to date on your plan if this was the case.

Elements table:

- The very first image is missing. Either find it or get rid of it entirely

Project proposal:

- Add feedback from teacher within your final proposal.

Project Planning:

- You have not completed review, packaging top or second character so please change your deadline date
- Add suitable commentaries of how you have done each task.

E-Portfolio:

- Incomplete. Your e-portfolio is a graphical product so it should reflect and “sell” your product.
- Your links on the top navigation bar do not always work. This needs to be corrected.
- Only one of your characters has been linked. Link the other also
- You have not yet converted your files, so this as a matter of urgency.

Characters

- Currently the separate character sheet showing dimensions does not open. You have used an incorrect file type.
- Annotate the character in design log and show where bitmap and vector images will be
- At present there is only one character in design log. So add the second character and annotate it.
- The character that does open does not have a title or key or instructions on it

E-Portfolio:

- The e-portfolio is difficult to navigate as you have to keep scrolling pages. Keep your examiner happy and change the length of your e-portfolio,
- Link to plan is not clear. Change colour or underline.
- Once in “Planning” the links on the navigation bar don’t work. Please Correct. The navigation bar only works sometimes.
- In characters menu, there is no link to 3D Characters
- Feedback for your 2d characters needs to be added to e-portfolio
- Link to the 2D enemy and the adjudicator are the wrong way around.
- The e-portfolio needs to be redesigned with the audience and examiner in mind.
- Lots of work missing so either update with correct links or pull your socks up and work very hard.

- Change title on homepage from Unit 2 to Unit 3
- Add your candidate details to the e-portfolio
- Add images of your 3d characters to the e-portfolio header.
- Second link on backdrop menu doesn't work
- Tell the tale link doesn't open story board it opens up the tell the tale presentation., The story board is in the design log.

Characters

- Need a separate character sheet showing dimensions for each character

- Why is backdrop in portrait and not landscape?
- Reference Jet in packaging top and describe how you edited it.
- Jet in backdrop needs to be referenced
- Timings need to be changed in tell the tale. At present too fast for particular audience.
- Consider the bitmap images on the pilot. i.e Why is there a picture on the back of the head?
- Clean up all the images so that no white background space can be seen around the edges.

E-Portfolio:

- It is not clear how you edited one of your 3D characters which appears in your e-portfolio and tell the tale. Please describe how the character was edited in order to make it fit for purpose.
- In characters menu, the link to 3D Characters and 2D characters works only on the border edges. Please correct as at first I thought the links were not present at all.
- Link to *feedback* in 3d character doesn't work
- There are four links in the 3d character section, both leading to only 2 images. Remove two of the links or add two other images and link correctly.
- Link to *feedback* in the "tell the tale" section isn't present.
- Link to dimensions of 2d character "dazzle" only shows dazzle. No dimensions present. Either link correctly or create dimension sheet.
- Some links in the backdrop section do not work. Please correct

Characters

- Annotate the character in design log and state clearly using ruler lines where bitmap and vector images will be
- Each character should have at least three colours. Both characters seem only to have two.
